HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR CITY OFFICES AND SERVICES

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 24, 2010 CHRISTMAS DAY - OBSERVED

Public Safety:

- Police and Fire emergency crews will not be impacted.
- Station 38 (citywide emergency dispatch center) will be on duty.

Other:

- There will be no delay in trash, yard waste, and curbside recyclables collection for customers served by the Environmental Services Department on Friday, December 24, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Landfill will be closed on Saturday, December 25, 2010. The Landfill will return to its normal operating schedule, from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Sunday, December 26, 2010.
- The City's automated waste container sales office at 8353 Miramar Place will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 23 and closed on Friday, December 24, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Household Hazardous Waste facility will be closed on Saturday, December 25, 2010. The facility will resume operations on Saturday, January 8, 2011.
- This holiday information for trash and recyclables collection is for the City of San Diego only. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.
- Mission Bay Golf Course will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 24 and on Christmas Day, Saturday, December 25, 2010. Torrey Pines and Balboa Park golf courses and starter booths will be open until 3:00 p.m. on Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25, 2010; holiday rates will apply at all courses.
- The Golf Administration office will be closed Friday, December 24 through Friday, December 31, 2010. Advance tee times and resident cards will be available Monday through Thursday during normal hours.

- Balboa Park will be open. All public buildings in Balboa Park will be closed. Some institutions will be open; please contact the individual institution of interest for operating hours.

Specific Closures within the City of San Diego:

- All Administrative Offices will be closed on Friday, December 24, 2010.
- The Testing, Employment Information Center and Background/Fingerprinting offices within the Personnel Department will be closed on Friday, December 24, 2010.
- Open Space and Maintenance Assessment District Offices will be closed on Friday, December 24, 2010.
- Chollas Lake will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, December 24, and closed on Saturday, December 25, 2010.
- Tecolote Nature Center will be closed on Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25, 2010.
- Mission Trails Regional Park Visitor Center will be closed on Saturday, December 25, 2010.
- All City recreation centers will be closed on Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25, 2010.
- All City pools will be closed on Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25, 2010.
- Robb Field Skate Park (Ocean Beach), Rancho Peñasquitos Skate Park, Carmel Valley Skate Park, Bill and Maxine Wilson Skate Park (702 South 30th St.), and the Charles L. Lewis III Memorial Skate Park (6610 Potomac St.) will be open on Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25, 2010.

- Parking meters, time restrictions on parking on streets and yellow zones within the City of San Diego will not be enforced on Friday, December 24 or Saturday, December 25, 2010. Red, white and blue zones are still enforced every day. Parking rules on Port property and in different cities may vary so please read signage provided.
