<b>HRB #</b>	Unique Site number to identify designated resources
<b>District Contributor ID#</b>	Unique Site number to identify contributors to a designated historical district
<b>Street #</b>	Address/House number of designated resource
<b>Street Name</b>	Street designated resource is located
<b>Zip Code</b>	Zip Code of designated resource
<b>APN</b>	Assessor's Parcel Number, is assigned to each legal parcel by the county assessor
<b>Comm. Plan Area</b>	Community planning area in which the designated resource is located
<b>Neighborhood</b>	Neighborhood in which the designated resources is located
<b>Date Designated</b>	Date property was designated as a historical resource
<b>Designation Criteria</b>	The criteria under which the resource was designated (A, B, C, D, E and F). For designation descriptions see <a href="#">Guidelines for the Application of Historical Resources Board Designation Criteria</a>
<b>Other Inventory Listings</b>	For properties that are listed on multiple historical registers (i.e. National, California, or Local)
<b>Architectural Style</b>	Style of architecture associated with the designated resource
<b>Year Built</b>	Year the designated resource was built
<b>Architect and/or Builder</b>	Person(s) whom designed/built the designated resource
<b>Historic Individual</b>	Significant person(s) whom are associated with the designated resource
<b>Historic District</b>	A geographic area established by the City which contains a group of historic resources which often have a common theme, architecture, or history
<b>Staff Report Number</b>	References the Staff report for the historical resource. The first two numeric digits correspond to the year (e.g. “HRB 07-031” is from 2007). Staff reports are listed by year <a href="#">here</a> .
