

## **Restricted Hours of Construction San Diego Municipal Code Section 59.5.0404.**

Excessive construction noise is not allowed during the time described below. Hand painting and shielded interior work that is not audible beyond the property would not generally be considered excessive noise. Off-site noise that is associated with a specific project such as staging of concrete trucks under residential properties prior to 7:00 AM is considered excessive noise.

Restricted hours of construction are:

- Between the hours of 7:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- Sundays
- Holidays which are:
  - January 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Third Monday in January, known as “Dr Martin Luther King, Jr.’s Birthday”
  - Third Monday in February, known as “Washington’s Birthday”
  - March 31<sup>st</sup>, known as “Cesar Chavez Day”;
  - Last Monday in May, known as “Memorial Day”;
  - July 4<sup>th</sup>;
  - First Monday in September, known as “Labor Day”;
  - November 11<sup>th</sup>, known as “Veteran’s Day”;
  - Fourth Thursday in November, known as “Thanksgiving Day”;
  - December 25<sup>th</sup>;

If January 1<sup>st</sup>, March 31<sup>st</sup>, July 4<sup>th</sup>, November 11<sup>th</sup> or December 25<sup>th</sup> falls upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday, and if they fall on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday.
