201. House of China proposal to install Foo Dogs.

<u>Special Events</u> (Special Events that require road or plaza closures, or will potentially impact park and/or institution operation, are brought to the Committee for a formal recommendation. They can be moved to consent by action of the committee.)

301. Healing Arts Festival – Ryan Altman, Alternative Healing Arts Network, Inc. Request approval to continue holding this event in Balboa Park with the following changes/improvements/stipulations: 1) Improve the parking/traffic/shuttle plan; 2) Fence the venue to limit the attendance to a manageable amount of attendees (10,000-15,000). A nominal entry fee would be charged; 3) Increase the event security force and SDPD presence; 4) Contract with a licensed service to clean-up after the event; 5) Agree to one "mid-range" entertainment headliner instead of three; and 6) Possibly conduct the event over two-days (Saturday & Sunday) in order to limit the daily attendance numbers.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: To approve the request to continue the event with changes and improvements listed on a one year trial basis to be reviewed after the 2010 event with the following requirement - A Park & Recreation Miscellaneous Staffing for Event Support fee will be charged to have at least one staff member work the entire permitted time to observe the event and report back to the Committee with a written report of their findings.

302. <u>San Diego Race for Autism</u> – Juan & Sharon Leon, National Foundation for Autism Research Request to modify the 5K course route which starts at the 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. Lawn area, South of El Prado. The major change will close the northbound lane of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave between Juniper St and Upas St. for approximately one and a half hours in the morning.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: To deny the request to modify the course route to close a portion of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and continue with the existing route for 2010 as they have done for five years without incident. Staff will continue to work with the event organizers to ensure minimal impacts to the park during the event.

303. <u>Circo Atayde USA</u> – John Whitfield, Sho Management, Inc
Proposal to bring a self-contained tent circus to Balboa Park from December 6-19,
2010. Approximately 250 parking spaces in the Lower Inspiration Parking lot will
be used to accommodate 24 performances between December 7 and December
14. The proposal includes the use of performing horses and dogs. The organizer
also requests permission to have performing tigers and camels, optional.
Estimated attendance over the seven performance dates is 20,000 guests.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: To approve the request to bring the tent circus to Balboa Park for a one time trial basis. Load in can only occur after the Balboa Park December Nights event loads out. Staff does not recommend allowing exotic animal to perform, domestic animals are okay. To be re-visited by the Balboa Park Committee after the 2010 event if they desire to return.
