



CHOLLAS LAKE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Fishing permitted for children 15 and under ONLY!
- Swimming or wading in the lake is not permitted at any time.
- Do not throw rocks or sticks at ducks or anything else.
- Keep pets on a leash and under control at all times.
- Clean up after your pet.
- Fires permitted in barbeques only (no open fires anywhere)
- Keep the park clean – stash your trash.
- Do not climb or carve on trees.
- Help the natural resources in the park. Protect all wildlife and vegetation.
- Report any violation to Lake Staff.



FISH AND GAME REGULATIONS

- One pole per fisherman.
- Do not cast in the vicinity of ducks, other people, or from the pier.
- Fish must be taken with single hook and line, not by net, spear, or hand.
- Snagging of fish prohibited (fish must take bait in mouth).
- No fish or part of fish caught in lake may be used as bait.
- Each angler must have their own stringer. If more than one angler's fish are on a stringer, all fish will be let loose.
- Fish may not be sold, traded, or given away.
- All state fish and game regulations strictly enforced especially size and limits.
- Do not enter the water or climb on any rocks while fishing.
