### FACILITY DESCRIPTIONS

The Paradise Hills Recreation Center has a full court gymnasium, meeting room, activity room, craft room, and kitchen. The community park features a lighted outdoor basketball court, two play areas, picnic areas with barbecue grills and shelter. There are walkways throughout the park. The lower portion of the park has a picnic shelter, comfort station, a decomposed granite quarter mile trail complete with par course around the trail for the fitness enthusiast.

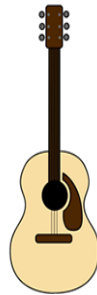


### **KRAFTY KRAFTS**
