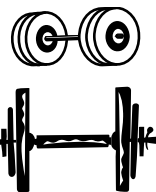

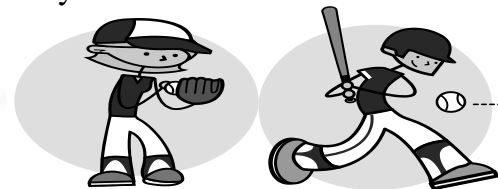

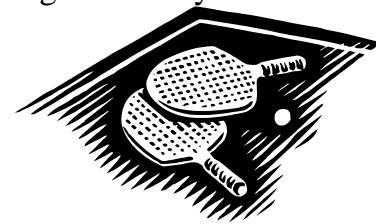


### **TABLE TENNIS**
