A Planned Development Permit (PDP) and a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) with the certification of a Mitigated Negative Declaration to amend the previously approve PDP No. 214066 and CUP No. 120471, to update the master plan for the school and increase the total student enrollment from 1,050 to 1,200 within the existing school structures on a 23.98-acre property.
