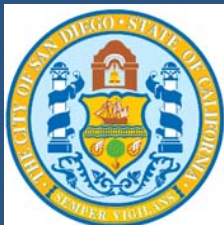

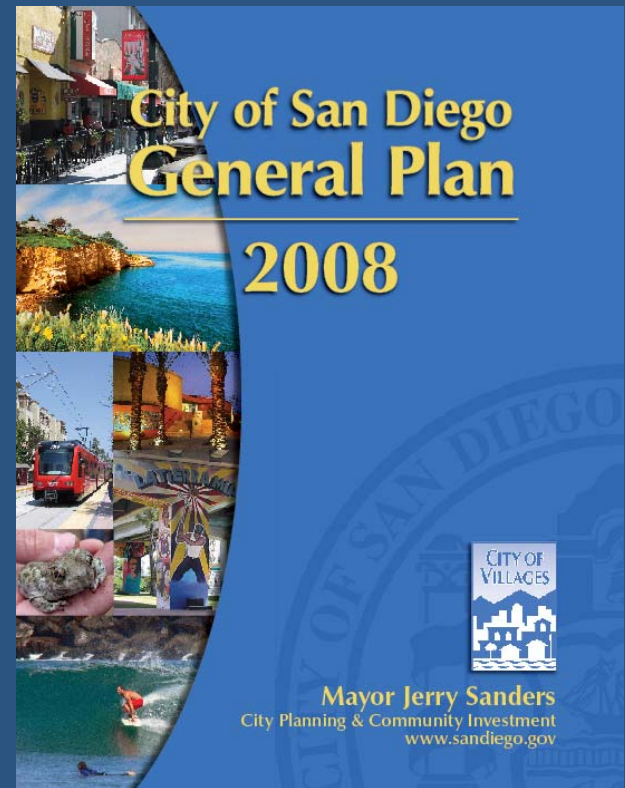

General Plan Adoption

- **March 10, 2008**
City Adopted a Comprehensive Update to the General Plan
- General Plan Action Plan (Action Plan) to identify implementation measures for General Plan goals and policies



The General Plan & Action Plan

- Fulfills state law requirements for General Plan implementation
- General Plan incorporates the Action Plan by reference after approval by City Council
- Implementation measures in the Action Plan must be consistent with General Plan policies
- Amendments or changes to the Action Plan consistent with the General Plan do not constitute an amendment to the General Plan

Action Plan Organization

- Organized by timeframe
 - Short-term 0-3 years
 - Mid-term 3-5 years
 - Long-term 5-10 years
 - Ongoing Existing work program or standard practice
- Links each policy to an implementation measure
- Identifies Departments responsible for implementation

Recent Edits

- Reformatted to organize actions by timeframe (short-, mid-, and long-term)
- Grouped similar actions within tables
- New actions on Climate Change, Water Conservation, and Storm Water
- Refinements to other actions throughout with input from responsible departments

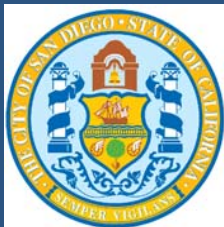
