

- IDEAS FROM THE GREATER GOLDEN HILL COMMUNITY**
- not enough parks
 - add tiny pocket parks on all city property
 - add community access to all fields
 - turn alleys into linear parks
 - more East-West bike paths
 - add hiking / biking trail around golf course
 - add free bicycle / motorcycle / scooter parking everywhere
 - Switzer Canyon restoration is an asset
 - no in-lieu fees — provide parking
 - allow additional green parking in all residential areas so owners can park in front of own driveways
 - limit density until infrastructure improvements are made
 - prohibit height increases that block sun or wind downstream
 - adopt mission pledge: benefits before all business / density increases
 - goal: add density to lowest density areas first — do not keep “dumping density” on same parts of our area — no linear ghettos
 - “City of Villages” provided few benefits except density
 - integrate community with — and through — the park
 - more pedestrian & bicycle friendly linkages across boundaries
 - lack of parks & open space
 - need preservation
 - maintain scale and historic / eclectic character of the community

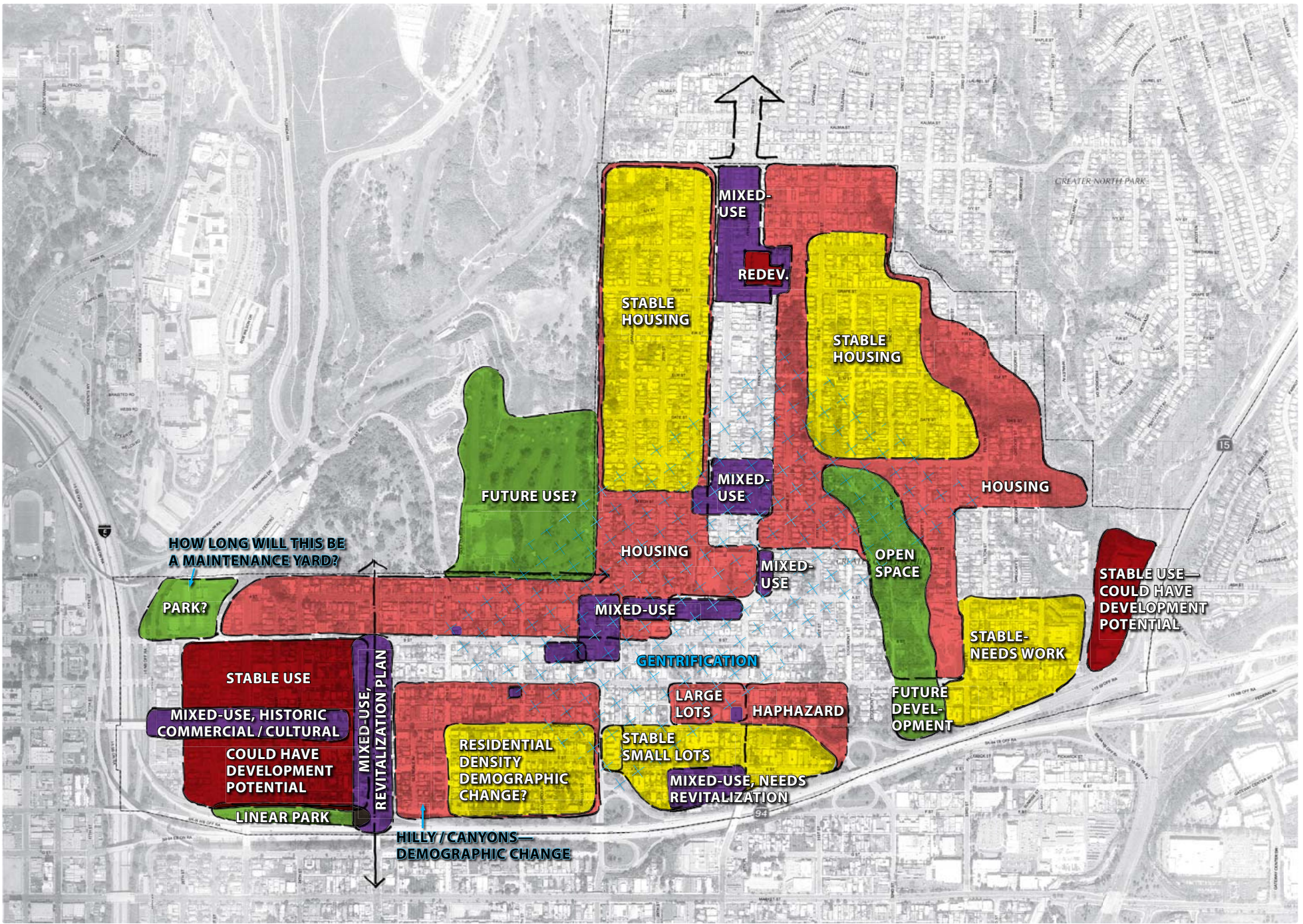
