Any Resident, Property Owner, Or Business Owner (Or Their Designee) Of The Navajo Communities (Allied Gardens, Del Cerro, Grantville, Or San Carlos) Is Eligible To Cast A Ballot (18 Yrs. Old Minimum Age Requirement). Additionally, You Must Bring Proof Of Residency (Drivers License, Utility Or Tax Bill).

Business Owners Must Show Proof Of Ownership (City Business License/Permit, Utility Or Property Tax Bill, As Well As A Photo ID (Drivers License Preferred). Only one (1) vote per business is permitted.

Non-Resident Property Owners Must Present Evidence Of Ownership, Such As A Utility Or Property Tax Bill And A Photo ID (Same As Above).

The By-Laws Of Navajo Community Planners, As Approved By The San Diego City Council, Mandate These Requirements. *Please Attended With The Appropriate Information In Order To Satisfy The Voting Eligibility Requirements.*
