(Candidates may make statements of interest; max. two minutes each. Printed ballots will be distributed to members of the Normal Heights Community who have attended at least one meeting prior to the Feb. 2013 meeting. Anonymous/secret balloting will be tallied and the seven candidates with highest qualifying number of votes become two-year term Board members at the April meeting. In the case of a tie involving the one-year-term open position, a run-off vote will be held.)
3. Nominating Committee to be formed to develop
 - a. A list of Officer Candidates from the elected board for election by the Board members at the April meeting. Officer positions include Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.
 - b. A list of Community Members eligible to be elected to vacant Board seats for remaining one-year terms; terms ending March 2014.
