Police Report: Motorcycle racing on Bandy Canyon/Santa Ysabel Creek for midnight filming of activities. Marc said between 40-50 people present

Old Business: Fatality during rush hour on a Friday caused traffic to be diverted to SYC Rd. Lee said nothing new we can discuss openly.

Joe brought up the River Pk trails being used after hours of closure. John said other communities are complaining as well. A bike patrol will be utilized to enforce hours and City will add funds for additional rangers. Joe asked for a phone number to report abuse. Jeff said all reservoir recreational areas are open only daylight hours

New Business: Jeff Pasek gave report of water purification plant (see report handout) Lee talked about the Bike Share program; will be only available in San Diego City but said to be a lucrative asset.

Frank put the SYC Rd on the Neighborhood Input for Infrastructure Priorities FY2015. Buttresses of Lake Hodges Dam was only project on plan. Priorities are SYC Rd, ambulance, San Pasqual Rd. Frank to get correct form to send. Matt moved to be part of the Priority Plan; Kody 2nd, unanimously approved. Ernie (absent) had asked if members wanted to donate items to Sykes Adobe in order to better educate public to SP Valley. Members asked to check with him
