7:30 pm Action Item 2: La Mirage Renovation: The Irvine Company, owner of La Mirage, has a proposed \$100 Million renovation that is seeking approval from the Tierrasanta Community Council. The purpose of the approval will be to amend Planned Development Permit PDP 98-0726. The renovation will consist of an additional 90-unit apartment building (134,225 sq. ft. structure), a gated vehicular entry with manned guards, street vacation to privatize internal loop road, and new community identification signage. Tonight's action is for council to listen to presentation from Irvine Company and refer to Community Development Committee.

8:20 pm Information Item 8: On March 19th, the Tierrasanta Community Council voted to convene the bylaws committee in order to respond to proposed changes by the City of San Diego Community Planners Committee and the City Attorney's office for all planning groups subject to Council Policy 600-24. Since the adjournment of the last TCC meeting, the fact that the TCC's corporate bylaws updated in 2011 and the TCC's community planning group bylaws updated in 2008 are inconsistent with each other because the Tierrasanta Open Space Committee and the Tierrasanta Recreation Council are listed as Standing Committees in the corporate bylaws but are not listed as Standing Committees in the planning group bylaws. The purpose of this informational item is to receive an update on progress from the By Laws Committee.
