3a. <u>Preservation Fund.</u> This is a continuation of the August 2013 discussion regarding a proposal to use monies from the Historic Preservation Fund for a study to identify the appropriate color for truncated domes in historic districts. The City has chosen "Federal Yellow" as the standard color for truncated domes placed within curb ramps in order to meet ADA requirements. This color may not be appropriate for sidewalk treatment within historic districts. The City Engineer has agreed to allow up to two additional colors in order to provide a more historically compatible color in these areas. A study of historic sidewalk colors within historic districts would help to determine which of the available colors would be most appropriate. Access Law Compliance staff from the Public Works Department will be available to address the requirements.
