3a. <u>Proposed Mission Hills and Fort Stockton Line Historic Districts</u>: The Historical Resources Section has begun processing the Mission Hills Historic district, currently bounded by Sunset Boulevard, Sheridan and Lyndon Streets and Saint James Place, (submitted in 2004 by Janet O'Dea and Allen Hazard); and the Fort Stockton Line Historic District, which follows the extension of the streetcar line along West Lewis and Fort Stockton Drive between Stephens and Trias, (submitted in 2006 by Barry Hager and Scott Sandel). These districts did not result directly from the Uptown Survey, but in some instances the information and boundaries closely reflect the information found in the survey. The documents are currently in the process of being updated by both staff and the applicants and staff is looking at scheduling the item for the required meetings and hearings in May and June. Staff is hosting a workshop on April 28th to introduce the historical districts, explain the process, responsibilities and benefits, and answer any questions the property owners may have. Staff is requesting Subcommittee member comments at this meeting regarding the context and proposed boundaries prior to forwarding the nominations to the Board. [Kelley Saunders; 90 minutes]
