Each member of the public is required to state their name and the organization (if any) that they represent prior to their one minute presentation.*

## MEETING AGENDA

1. Introductions
2. Public Comment (on matters within the subcommittee's purview and not on the agenda)
3. Discussion Topics:
  1. Evaluation criteria for determining what constitutes a historic interior.
  2. Public vs. private ownership.
  3. Whether or not owner consent is needed to designate interior elements of single family residences.
  4. Public access/visibility of the interior elements.
  5. The need for the research report to address the historical or architectural significance of the interior elements that should be considered for designation.
  6. The need for Board Members to visually inspect any interior elements being considered for designation.
  7. Property owner assistance from DAS in determining rehabilitation approaches that are consistent with the Standards and Guidelines.
  8. The treatment of non-designated historic building interiors on a voluntary basis.

It is anticipated that discussion on all topics will conclude with this meeting and no further subcommittee meetings would be scheduled. A report with recommendations would be forwarded to the full HRB following conclusion of the subcommittee's work.
