SDPD ASKING FOR ASSISTANCE IN LOCATING A FATAL HIT-AND-RUN DRIVER

(San Diego) San Diego Police Traffic Division detectives are asking for assistance from the public in locating the driver and vehicle involved in a fatal hit and run collision. The collision occurred at about 1:50 a.m. on Wednesday morning October 11, 2006 at 4700 Pacific Highway. A male pedestrian was crossing the street about mid-block; he was headed east bound and was struck by a car that was traveling north bound on Pacific Highway.

The suspect's vehicle is a white or light-colored SUV, possibly a Mercedes Benz M-Class. The vehicle has tinted rear windows. There may be damage to the front hood, grill and windshield. Additionally, the right front headlight may be non-operational, but not broken. The car was driven by a woman with her hair pulled back who appeared to be short in stature. We have no further information on the driver's description.
