Police Looking for Suspects in Linda Vista Double Homicide

Release Date: October 27, 2006

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit, is asking for the public's assistance to help identify the suspects responsible for a double homicide in Linda Vista.

On March 29, 2006 at approximately 1:00am, Tarryk Brown (aka Swift) and Louie McRae (aka Butchie) were murdered in the 2400 block of West Ingersoll Street; a third victim was also seriously injured. A white 4-door vehicle, similar in appearance to a Ford Escort, was seen leaving the area at the time of the homicide.

The San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit developed a flyer that they have distributed in the neighborhood. The flyer has several pictures of a vehicle similar to the one seen driving away at the time of the homicide. *A copy of the flyer is attached to this release*.

Anyone with information on the identity and/or location of the suspect(s) responsible for the murders of Brown and McRae is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS.** Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the suspect(s). Collect calls are accepted and callers may remain anonymous.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous. The qualification of any person(s) for the reward and the amount of the reward for any person(s) so qualifying will be determined by San Diego County Crime Stoppers, Inc, in its sole discretion.
