SDPD SEEKING RECRUITS; NEXT TESTING SCHEDULED DECEMBER 2, 6 AND 8

(San Diego) The San Diego Police Department is hiring and will conduct testing during the first week of December for those interested in becoming officers.

The Mayor and the City Council have committed the necessary funding to increase the number of San Diego police officers. As a result, SDPD is actively recruiting new hires and lateral transfers (officers currently working for other law enforcement agencies).

- Testing on December 2, 2006 will take place at the Naval Training Center (NTC), 4347 North Harbor Drive beginning at 8 a.m.
- Testing on December 6 will take place at San Diego Police Headquarters, 1401 Broadway Street beginning at 6 p.m.
- Testing on December 8 will take place at the Balboa Park Club Ballroom, located at 2150 West Pan American Road beginning at 8 a.m.

If the applicant passes the written exam he or she will be asked to return on December 9, for the physical ability test and the pre-investigative questionnaire.

Applicants must be at least 20 ½ at the time of the written test and 21 by their academy graduation date. A high school diploma or equivalency is required.
