Detectives Seek Public's Assistance To Help Identify Three Suspects Wanted in Connection with a Stabbing in Lemon Grove

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with detectives from the San Diego Sheriff's Department to help identify and apprehend three suspects wanted for assault with a deadly weapon.

On October 21, 2006, at approximately 8:00 p.m., a man was confronted by three Hispanic males inside the Arco gas station located at 6901 Federal Blvd. in Lemon Grove. Suspect #1 verbally threatened the victim while Suspect #2 moved to the front door blocking the exit. Suspect #3 moved to the other side of the victim preventing him from moving. Suspect #2 then stabbed the victim in the left shoulder area. All three suspects fled the scene and were last seen driving away in a newer model, silver 2-door Honda or Acura.

The suspects are described as follows:

Suspect #1 is a Hispanic male about 5'8" tall weighing about 230 lbs. He had a shaved head, goatee and was wearing a short sleeve, black, striped shirt.

Suspect #2 is a Hispanic male described as 6'0" weighing about 160 lbs with short black hair. He was wearing a white t-shirt.

Suspect #3 is a Hispanic male who is about 5'6" tall and weighs about 140 lbs. He had a shaved head and a mustache. He was wearing a black and gray pendleton shirt.
