SAN DIEGO POLICE INVESTIGATE MCDONALD'S ROBBERY **(Video available)**

(San Diego) The San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit is investigating a robbery that occurred on October 28, 2006, at the McDonald's Restaurant at 7085 Clairemont Mesa Boulevard. At about 10:55 p.m. the suspect was dropped off in front of the restaurant. He walked inside and approached the counter. He went through his pockets and then walked back around behind the counter and aimed a black semi-automatic handgun (equipped with a scope and possibly a silencer) at the cashier. The suspect told the cashier to give him the money. When the cashier told him she could not open the register, the suspect walked to the back of the restaurant to get the keys. He returned to the counter, opened the register and grabbed the cash. The suspect then ran out of the restaurant.

The suspect is described as a black male adult, 29-30 years old, bald or shaved head with a scar on the left side of his head. He was clean-shaven and had an earring in his left ear. He was wearing a dark hooded jacket, dark jeans and white tennis shoes.

The vehicle that dropped the suspect off at the restaurant is described as a newer model black Nissan Altima with custom chrome wheels.

There is excellent quality video of the suspect available at the SDPD front counter (until 5 p.m.)
