Suspect Arrested in Pedestrian Robbery of 70-Year-Old Female

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego Police Department's Central Division announce the arrest of a suspect in the pedestrian robbery of a 70-year-old female at a gas station.

Detectives said on September 11, 2007, at about 11:35 p.m., a male suspect robbed and battered a 70-year-old female as she walked towards the Shell Gas Station at 1011 A Street in San Diego. The victim sustained several lacerations to her face and head. The suspect succeeded in taking the victim's bag.

As a result of two calls to the SD County Crime Stoppers tip line, a 14-year-old male suspect was arrested on October 19, 2007 and will be charged with robbery and assault with a deadly weapon. He is currently being held in juvenile hall.

A store surveillance camera recorded the robbery and that video has been posted on the SDPD Media Services web page (http://www.sandiego.gov/police/about/media/news07.shtml) under Crime Stoppers News Releases.
