Detectives Release Photos of Assault Suspects

Release Date: July 20, 2007

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Department, is seeking the public's assistance to identify and locate the suspects in an assault with a deadly weapon case.

On June 2, 2007, at approximately 8:30 a.m., a Hispanic male victim was assaulted by two Hispanic males and one Hispanic female at the City Heights street fair in the 3700 block of Fairmount Avenue. The victim was hit on the top of the head with a blunt instrument by one of the three suspects and seriously injured.

Still photos of all three suspects are attached to this release.

Detectives are looking for information on the identity and location of the three suspects involved in this case. Anyone with information on this case can call the Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of these suspects. Collect calls are accepted and callers may remain anonymous.
