### SUSPECT VEHICLE IN CUSTODY (8/6/07 2:40 P.M.)

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division to help identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for a double-fatal, hit and run collision.

On August 3, 2007 at about 2 a.m. a BMW and a pickup truck were driving at a high rate of speed at 4700 Fairmount Avenue. After the two vehicles crashed the driver of the truck left the scene of the collision.

Witnesses say the suspect vehicle is a metallic blue 2005 Toyota Tacoma pickup with an air dam on the hood. There is left front (driver's side) quarter panel damage to the vehicle as a result of the collision. The driver was a male, but we have no further description on him. (Photos of a Tacoma pickup similar to the suspect vehicle are attached.)

There were three occupants in the BMW; two died in the crash and one was seriously injured and is still in the hospital.
