San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division to help apprehend the suspect responsible for a double-fatal, hit and run collision.

On August 3, 2007 at about 2 a.m. a BMW and a pickup truck were driving at a high rate of speed at 4700 Fairmount Avenue. After the two vehicles crashed the driver of the truck left the scene of the collision. There were three occupants in the BMW; two died in the crash and one was seriously injured and is still in the hospital.

The suspect vehicle is a metallic blue 2005 Toyota Tacoma pickup. This vehicle was taken into custody on August 6, 2007 in North Park.

The person of interest in this case is Carlos Mejia Catalan, 19. A photo of Catalan can be found on Page 2 of this news release.
