## Identity Theft Suspect Sought; Two No-Bail Felony Warrants Issued

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, along with San Diego County Probation Department, are seeking the public's assistance to help locate a suspect wanted for two no-bail felony warrants.

Probation Officers said Shannon Smith is wanted for violating the conditions of her probation; Smith has two outstanding felony warrants for check forgery and identity theft. Smith has a history of drug use and has used stolen mail in the past to assume false identities and obtain fraudulent checks and credit cards.

Shannon Smith is a white female, 5'8" tall, 160 lbs, brown hair and blue eyes. See attached picture of Smith.

Anyone with information on the location of Shannon Smith is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of this suspect. Collect calls are accepted and callers may remain anonymous.
