**WANTED BULLETIN**

**CHARGE:** 187 (a) P.C. Murder, San Diego Police Case #07-066056

**SUSPECT :**

Hispanic male, 18-20, slender build, thin mustache, wearing a white Padre baseball cap and a white vertical striped polo shirt. The vehicle was described as a 2002 to 2004, black, Toyota 4-Runner or similar type SUV, clean with chrome running boards and a roof rack.

**NARRATIVE:**

The victim Larry IRVING was involved in an argument with the above described male. IRVING was standing on the running board of the suspect's car. IRVING and the suspect were punching each other as the car was being driven south on 17<sup>th</sup> Street approaching J Street. The suspect stopped and IRVING fell into the street. The suspect then accelerated into IRVING. IRVING received critical injuries. IRVING later died at the hospital from his injuries.
