MISSING PERSON AT RISK

(San Diego) Julius T. Fifer, 58, a resident of Sacramento, was visiting his mother who lives in the Castle neighborhood of Mid City. He is a terminal cancer patient who takes medication for his condition. On October 7, 2007 at about 5 p.m. Fifer left his mother's home to go to a grocery store at 3800 Fairmount Avenue; he borrowed his sister's van to do so. He has not been seen since then. Fifer has not taken his medication since yesterday and this causes him to be disoriented and appear under the influence of alcohol.

The van Fifer was driving is a maroon 1996 Dodge Van with tinted windows and a California license plate of 6K70317. Fifer is a black male, 5'8" 260 lbs, black and gray hair, and brown eyes. He was wearing a white shirt, white long shorts and brown sandals with no socks. A photo of Fifer can be found on page two of this news release.

Fifer's wife in Sacramento has not heard from him, nor has his family here locally. He is not familiar with the San Diego area.
