Sexual Assault Suspect Sought; Detectives Looking for Assistance From the Public

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department's Sex Crimes detectives to help identify and apprehend the suspect responsible for the sexual assault and kidnap of a woman.

On July 25, 2007 at about 8:30 p.m. at Florida and Lincoln Streets, the male suspect threatened the female victim at knifepoint. He forced her into her vehicle where he sexually assaulted her.

The suspect is a white male in his mid 30s to early 40s, 5'10" thin build, with receding dark blonde hair a moustache and thick and large prescription glasses. (A composite of the suspect can be found on page two of this news release.)

The suspect has been seen walking around the North Park area in the past six months.

Anyone with information on the identity and/or location of this suspect should call the Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free tip line at (888) 580-TIPS. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of this suspect.
