Detectives Seek Public's Help to Identify Four Burglary Suspects Caught on Surveillance Video

Release Date: January 25, 2007

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with San Diego Police Department Northeastern detectives, is seeking the public's assistance to identify and locate the suspects responsible for burglarizing a local business.

On 1-21-07, sometime between the hours of midnight and 8 a.m., the Virtual Realm, a video gaming center located at 7128 Miramar Road #15 in San Diego, was burglarized by four unknown suspects. The suspects took eight large screen plasma televisions, fourteen computers with monitors, and an undetermined amount of game stations. The loss is estimated at more than \$100,000.

All four suspects were caught on surveillance video. Still photos taken from the video surveillance camera are attached to this release. A DVD copy of the surveillance video is available at the police headquarters front counter at 1401 Broadway Street.

Anyone with information on the identity or location of these suspects is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of these suspects. Collect calls are accepted and callers may remain anonymous.
