SDPD AND THE FBI SEEK BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT FROM WELLS FARGO BANK

(San Diego) San Diego Police Robbery Unit detectives and the FBI are investigating a robbery of the Wells Fargo Bank at 8898 Navajo Road in the San Carlos community.

On October 2, 2007 at about 4:30 p.m., a male robbed the bank of an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect is described as a white male, 20-25 years old, approximately 5'11" to 6'1" tall with a thin build. The suspect was wearing a black baseball cap with the word "Sox" on it in white letters, white muscle shirt, levis, a black belt with a large round buckle and black shoes.
