San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Eastern Division detectives to identify and locate an unidentified female and her companion for theft of a credit card.

On November 8, 2008 an unknown male stole a purse from an employee at Michael's in Mission Valley. The victim's ATM card was used the next day by a female at several locations for a total of more than \$500 in purchases. In addition, a check for \$1700 was written at the Bed Bath & Beyond Store in Mission Valley. Surveillance photos of the female suspect were obtained from a couple of the locations where she used the stolen card. This female suspect was also accompanied by another female.

Suspect description: White or Hispanic female, unknown age. She has shoulder-length dark hair and a medium build. This suspect was also in the company of another female with a similar physical description.
