Robbery Series Suspect Caught on Tape

April 18, 2008

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit detectives to help identify and apprehend a suspect responsible for robbing at least six different San Diego businesses.

Between March 24, 2008 and April 13, 2008, an unknown Hispanic male suspect robbed five gas stations and one flower shop in San Diego. The suspect displayed a handgun in the robberies but no one has been injured. During one of the robberies, the suspect was caught on surveillance video.

Surveillance video of the suspect is available at the San Diego Police Department headquarters front counter, 1401 Broadway.

Suspect description:

Suspect: Hispanic male, 18-25 years-old, 5'4" tall, 130-150 lbs. with brown hair and brown eyes.

Robbery detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and/or location of this suspect to call the Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free tip line at (888) 580-TIPS. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of this suspect:
