## **Robbery Suspect Caught on Tape**

January 31, 2008

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego Police Department Western Division detectives to help identify and apprehend two suspects responsible for robbing a Fashion Valley shopper.

On January 25, 2008, at about 9:25 p.m., a female suspect grabbed a purse from a female shopper as she walked through the Fashion Valley mall parking structure. The victim chased the suspect through the parking structure and into a gold or silver 4-door sedan. In an attempt to recover her purse, the victim jumped into the suspect's vehicle and a struggle ensued. A second suspect, described only as a white male, was also in the vehicle. The male suspect and the female suspect both struggled with the victim in the vehicle. Eventually the male suspect started to drive the vehicle away, and coupled with the struggle, caused the victim to fall out of the vehicle with her purse.

Suspect description:

Suspect #1: Hispanic female, 20-25 years-old, 5'5"-5'6" tall, 120-125 lbs. with short brown hair. Puffy brown jacket with brown fur collar, striped black & grey sweatshirt, blue jean pants and black ballet slippers.

Suspect #2: White male. No other information available.

Suspect vehicle: Gold or possibly silver 4-door sedan

Western Division detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and/or location of these suspect(s) to call the Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free tip line at (888) 580-TIPS. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of these suspects.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous. The qualification of any person(s) for the reward and the amount of the reward for any person(s) so qualifying will be determined by San Diego County Crime Stoppers, line, in its sole discretion.
