Burglary/Assault Suspects Sought \$1,000 Reward

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with Naval Criminal Investigative Service to help identify and apprehend several suspects responsible for burglarizing a construction trailer and assaulting a retired California Highway Patrol Officer.

On April 14, 2008, between 0100 and 0200, a retired CHP officer (the victim) was attacked by two masked suspects after he interrupted a burglary of a nearby office trailer occupied by Clark Construction located at Naval Station San Diego, 3301 Main Street, San Diego, CA. The victim was severely beaten by the suspects with a 2x4 and later admitted into the intensive care unit and is still in critical condition.

Numerous computers and office equipment were taken from the Clark's Construction trailer. Several pictures of computers similar to those stolen and the model description can be found on page 2 of this release.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and/or location of the suspects to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous toll-free** tip line at (888) 580-TIPS. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of these suspects.
