San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the National City Police Department's homicide unit, is seeking any information regarding the murder of Romel Velarde.

On January 19, 2007, at about 6:30 p.m., 16-year-old Romel Velarde was shot and killed in front of his house. Velarde was standing in his driveway located in the 2300 block of East Division Street in National City. Two unidentified males were seen running from the area. A brown van or sports utility vehicle was seen driving away from the area immediately after the murder.

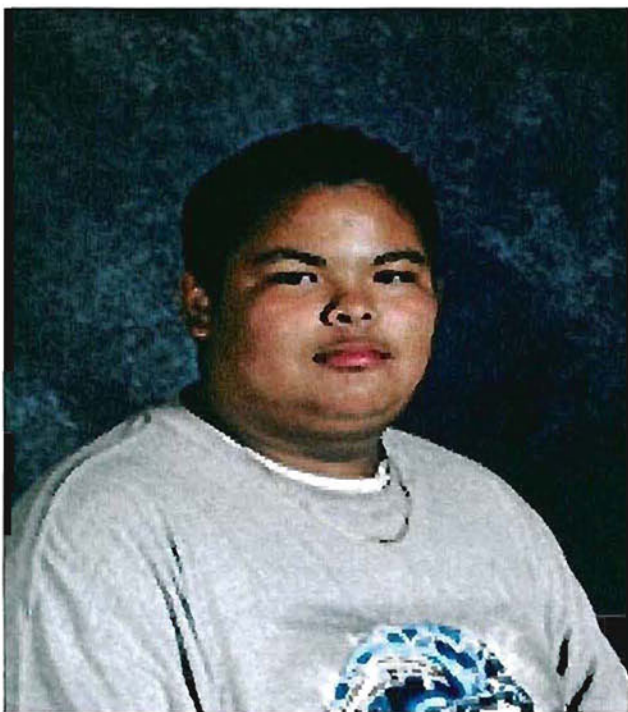

Anyone with any information on who murdered Romel Velarde is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.
