**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** is joining forces with San Diego Police Department's Elder Abuse detectives to help locate and apprehend the suspect responsible for stealing money and gold coins from an elderly victim.

Sometime between October 1 and October 18, 2008 Raymond George Wilkins stole \$13,000 in cash and Krugerrand gold coins from a 92 year old victim. Wilkins was living with the victim and acting as a temporary caregiver at the time of the theft.

Investigators have reason to believe that the suspect, Raymond George Wilkins, purchased a one way ticket to Oahu, Hawaii.

Raymond George Wilkins is described as a 34-year-old white male adult. He is 5'9" and weighs about 180 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.

Raymond Wilkins is an avid surfer and is known to hang out in the Pacific Beach area.
