ROBBERY SUSPECTS SOUGHT

(San Diego) San Diego Police Robbery Unit detectives are asking for assistance from the public in identifying two suspects believed responsible for three commercial robbery cases that occurred between May 2 and May 15, 2009.

On May 2 at about 3:20 a.m. an armed suspect robbed the AM/PM Mini Market located at Black Mountain Road and Mira Mesa Boulevard. The suspect was described as a white male in his 20s, 5'7" – 5'10" dirty blonde or light brown unkempt hair with long sideburns. He had a thin build and was wearing a black jacket, blue jeans and tennis shoes. He was armed with a handgun. The suspect got away with cash and several packs of cigarettes. No one was injured in this case.

On May 15, 2009 at about 11:30 p.m. two male suspects robbed the AM/PM Mini Market located in the 12000 block of Scripps Summit Drive. Robbery detectives believe the same suspect in the May 2 case committed this armed commercial robbery as well. His description, including the clothing worn, was described as the same as in the previous case. Suspect #1 was accompanied by a white male (suspect #2), 5'7" – 5'10" with a thin build. He wore a white t-shirt over a hooded sweatshirt, gray pants and tan shoes or work boots. The suspects left with cash and several cartons of cigarettes. Witnesses describe the suspect vehicle as a red Ford Ranger pickup or Toyota pickup. No one was injured in this case.

On May 15, 2009 at about 11:45 p.m. Robbery detectives believe the same two suspects robbed the AM/PM Mini Market located at Black Mountain Road and Mira Mesa Boulevard (for the second time in the same month). The loss in this case was cash.

The suspect descriptions are the same in the second and third cases, as well as the suspect vehicle description.
