Fugitive of the Week

Friday – January 16, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Regional Fugitive Task Force, continue their weekly fugitive apprehension program for the County of San Diego.

There are approximately 18,000 outstanding warrants for suspects who have committed felony crimes in the County of San Diego. Every Friday, San Diego County Crime Stoppers will send a news release identifying a high profile fugitive wanted for a serious felony crime. We strongly encourage all San Diego news media outlets to feature this fugitive during their Friday and weekend news broadcasts and publications.

This Week's Fugitive: Julio Mario Pacheco is wanted by the San Diego Regional Fugitive Task Force on a \$750,000 felony warrant for attempted murder. Pacheco assaulted his girlfriend with a hammer.

Fugitive Description: Julio Mario Pacheco (a.k.a. Mario Pacheco Barrera) is a 37 year old Hispanic male. He is 5'6" tall and weighs about 160 lbs. Pacheco has black hair and brown eyes.

Julio Mario Pacheco is known to frequent the Logan Heights area of San Diego County and may be working in the construction field.

Anyone with any information on the location of this suspect is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers' anonymous tip line at (888) 580-TIPS; you can also email or text anonymously at www.sdcrimestoppers.com**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous.
