San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit to help apprehend the suspect responsible for an armed robbery that occurred on July 14, 2009 in the North City area.

The suspect entered the Juice It Up at 2600 Via de la Valle at about 6:40 p.m. He chatted with the clerk for a few minutes; left the store briefly and then returned. He displayed a handgun and demanded money. After getting an undisclosed amount of money from the cashier he fled on foot. No vehicle was seen by the witnesses.

Two photos of the suspect can be found on page two of this news release and surveillance video is available at the SDPD headquarters front counter until 5 p.m. today.

Suspect description:

- White male, mid 20s, 5'6" to 5'9", 160 lbs. with a medium build. He was clean-shaven and wore a dark baseball cap with white lettering on the front. He was wearing a dark sweatshirt and long jean shorts.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
