## **Attempted Kidnap Suspect Sought**

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

December 14, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Southern Division detectives to help apprehend the suspect responsible for an attempted kidnapping case that occurred on December 7, 2009 in Nestor.

At about 3:30 p.m. a 15-year-old female high school student was walking home from Southwest High School. When she reached the 1300 block of Oro Vista Road a male in a red, four-door car reached out through the passenger window and grabbed her arm. As he was trying to open his car door, she hit him in the face and ran back to campus to get help.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 32-35 years old, with an average build, and a thick bushy mustache. He was wearing a black sweatshirt with the hood pulled over his head and he spoke only Spanish to the victim.

The vehicle is described as possibly a 1999-2002 four-door, red, Pontiac Grand Am that was very clean and without any noticeable modifications.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity of this suspect to call the Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477.
