## Theft Suspect Sought

### Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

August 5, 2009

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department Central Division detectives to help apprehend the suspect responsible for stealing a Rolex watch from a Horton Plaza jewelry store.

*On July 27, 2009 at about 3:45 p.m. the suspect walked into the Ben Bridge Jewelry Store in Horton Plaza. He asked to see a Rolex Presidential watch valued at \$24,000. The employee showed him the watch and the suspect then asked to see another watch for comparison. When the employee turned to get another watch, the suspect fled with the Presidential in hand. He ran through the shopping center and into the parking garage where a female was waiting for him in a silver, four-door Mercedes Benz.*

Suspect description:

- Black male, 20-25 years old, about 5'8" to 5'10" tall, 160-180 lbs. The suspect has a goatee and was dressed in a black, three-piece suit.

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the location or identity of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest.
