One Year Anniversary of the Unsolved Murder of Salvador Hernandez

\$1,000 Reward

Release Date: February 16, 2009

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego Police Department's homicide unit, is seeking any information regarding the murder of Salvador Hernandez.

On February 16, 2008, at approximately 3:30 a.m., 26-year-old Salvador Hernandez and a female companion were inside a parked car in the 5500 block of Seifert Street in the neighborhood of Chollas Creek. An unknown older light colored pick-up truck pulled alongside Salvador's vehicle and shot both him and his companion. Salvador's companion survived, however he died as a result of his wounds.

Salvador's family and friends will be available for media interviews today at 3:45 p.m. at the Holy Spirit Church at 2725 55th Street; a Mass dedicated to Salvador will be held at 4:30 p.m.

A picture of the victim, Salvador Hernandez, is on page two of this release.

Anyone with any information on who murdered Salvador Hernandez is asked to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line** at (888) 580-8477. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest.
