## **Commercial Burglary Series**

**Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered**

August 27, 2009

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** and detectives from SDPD Northeastern and Eastern Divisions need assistance from the public in locating the suspect responsible for a series of commercial burglaries that have taken place in August 2009.

Sixteen burglaries have occurred at closed restaurants in Mira Mesa and along Convoy Street in Kearny Mesa. The suspect gains entry by smashing a window. He goes directly to the cash register and takes cash; then leaves immediately.

The suspect appears to be a male of medium height and weight, wearing casual clothing and tennis shoes. He wears a baseball cap pulled over his eyes and pulls his jacket up around his ears and face so that his face isn't distinguishable.

Tips for business owners/operators:

- Do not leave cash in the register over night  
If register is visible from the window – leave drawer open indicating that it is empty
- Always set the alarm
