What: STAR/PAL's Annual Surf Clinic

STAR/PAL's Annual Surf Clinic brings together law enforcement officers, firefighters & lifeguards from a variety of agencies in San Diego County to teach 50 boys & girls the fundamentals of surfing while learning about water safety. Youth (9-13 years old) have been selected from underserved communities to participate in the program.

**Why:** Law enforcement program directors from STAR/PAL and other dedicated volunteers from

partner agencies educate youth about water safety, as well as the importance of living an active and healthy lifestyle through outdoor enrichment activities. By interacting with police and probation officers through positive activities, youth often find them to be relatable role models. These relationships help deter youth from negative peer influences.

Who: Participants: 50 boys & girls selected from inner-city neighborhoods, Child Welfare

Services, and the Monarch School for homeless youth.
