ARRESTS MADE IN 3 COMMERCIAL ROBBERIES THROUGHOUT SAN DIEGO

(San Diego) San Diego Police Department announces the arrest of four suspects in a series of commercial robberies that occurred on December 27-28, 2010.

On December 27, 2010, two black males and a black female entered the Postal Annex store 6051 Business Center Court #4 in Ocean Crest and robbed the clerk at gunpoint. The suspects took cash from the registers and portable phones from the business.

On December 28, 2010, at about 4:45 a.m., two black males and a black female wearing bandanas to cover their faces used a handgun to rob the clerk at the Circle K store at 17011 West Bernardo Drive in Rancho Bernardo. During the robbery, they stole cash and cigarettes from the store, as well as the clerk's purse. About 55 minutes later, the suspects robbed the 7-11store at 8261 Gold Coast Drive in Mira Mesa. When the clerk was unable to open the cash register, one of the suspects hit him in the head with a handgun. The suspects took several boxes of cigarettes before leaving the store.

While responding to the Mira Mesa robbery scene, a San Diego Police officer stopped a vehicle occupied by several people who matched the descriptions of the robbery suspects. The suspects were detained and later arrested. A handgun and property from all 3 robberies was recovered inside the vehicle.

Marquis Dontriel Brooks (19) of Chula Vista, Jeremiah Caleb Jimerson (19) of San Diego, Marquisia Shanay Bowser (22) of Chula Vista and Tommy Li Jacquett (32) of San Diego were all arrested on several counts of commercial robbery. A fifth male was detained and later released after questioning.

San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit detectives are continuing the investigation.
