## Public's Help Needed to Identify Shooting Suspects \$1,000 Reward Offered

January 15, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with the San Diego Police Department's Southeastern Division investigators to help identify and apprehend the suspect(s) responsible for an assault with a deadly weapon.

On January 14, 2010, at approximately 11:00 p.m., the victim was dropping off her co-worker at the Knox Glen Apartments at 4700 Logan Avenue in San Diego. After her co-worker exited the car, three unknown black males approached the victim's car. One of the suspects fired several rounds from a handgun striking the victim and her vehicle several times. The victim survived her wounds and was treated at a local hospital.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity of the person(s) responsible for this crime to call the Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.

For information leading to an arrest, you could receive up to a \$1,000 reward and remain anonymous.
