HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR CITY OFFICES AND SERVICES

MONDAY, JANUARY 18, 2010 MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY

EMERGENCIES:

- Police and Fire emergency crews will be on duty.
- Patrol Officers will be on duty.
- Station 38 (citywide emergency dispatch center) will be on duty.

Other:

- There will be a one-day delay in trash, yard waste, and curbside recyclables collection for customers served by the Environmental Services Department beginning Monday, January 18, 2010 due to the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. For example, Monday's collection will occur on Tuesday, with Friday's collection occurring on Saturday.
- Trash and recycling collection will return to its normal schedule Monday, January 25, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Landfill will be open slightly shortened hours on the holiday, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The Landfill will return to its normal operating schedule, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Tuesday, January 19, 2010.
- Vehicles that require hand unloading of trash at the Miramar Landfill will not be admitted after 4 p.m.
- The City's "refuse/recyclables" container sales office on Miramar Place will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- This holiday information for trash and recyclables collection is for the City of San Diego only. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.
- Golf courses and starter booths will be open holiday hours on Monday, January 18, 2010 and holiday rates will apply.
- Balboa Park will be open. All public buildings in Balboa Park will be closed. Museums that operate on Mondays will be open.

Specific Closures within the City of San Diego:

- All Administrative Offices will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- The Testing, Employment Information Center and Background/Fingerprinting offices within the Personnel Department will also be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- Open Space and Maintenance Assessment District Offices will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- Tecolote Nature Center will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- Mission Trails Regional Park Visitor Center will be open on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- All City recreation centers will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- All City pools will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- Chollas Lake will be open from dawn to dusk on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- The Robb Field Skate Park (Ocean Beach), Rancho Peñasquitos Skate Park, Carmel Valley Skate Park, Bill and Maxine Wilson Skate Park (702 South 30th St.), and the Charles L. Lewis III Memorial Skate Park (6610 Potomac St.) will be open on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- All libraries will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2010.
- Parking meters, time restrictions on parking on streets and yellow zones within the City of San Diego will not be in force. Red, white and blue zones are still enforced every day. Parking rules on Port property and in different cities may vary so please read signage provided.
