(San Diego) -- Mayor Bob Filner and First Lady Bronwyn Ingram joined students from Cherokee Point Elementary School at the Winter Shelter in downtown San Diego to speak with the homeless in an effort to truly understand their plight. The students spent time getting to know them and learned they are like the rest of us, people with hopes and dreams, but who have fallen on hard times.
